The reality is that it is often tricky, with days filled with never-ending problems and issues to solve. By practicing gratitude daily, you will be rewarded by one of the most influential people in your life - you.

GETTING A GRIP on hand and specialty tool sales

While some technicians want the "latest and greatest" hand and specialty tools, others look at how they will save them on time. Keeping up with the latest advancements will prove to be valuable - in both situations.

Ithough hand and specialty tools may not be as glamorous or exciting as diagnostic and power tools, they are just as important to any automotive technician. As with other tools, hand tools and specialty tools are constantly evolving. Keeping your customers up to date with the latest advancements will help them work faster, therefore putting more money in their pockets as well as yours.

For independent tool distributor James Stinson, hand and specialty tools make up the majority of his sales. Located in central Georgia, Stinson visits shops ranging from dealerships, small repair shops, truck shops to even some mining shops.

Even while busy on the road, Stinson makes it a point to always keep a working relationship with his own community. It's important to him and, by doing so, helps his business. In fact, his latest big-ticket hand tool sale stemmed from a call from a local foundation asking for his help.

As part of a grant, the foundation was looking to provide select graduating automotive and diesel students from the nearby vocational technical college with various hand tools to help jumpstart their careers.

"They gave me a list of items that the students might like to have, and I

fulfilled it as much as I could with the amount they gave me," Stinson says.

While giving the foundation a good discount, he was able to provide the students with pry bars, torque wrenches, wrenches, ratchets, sockets, and screwdrivers, to name a few.

"I try to keep a good relationship with the instructors," Stinson says. "They call on me from time to time with different things, so it worked out pretty well."

Having been around the tool selling business his whole life – his father retired as a mobile tool dealer in 2015 – Stinson understands the importance of helping his customers, taking care of their needs, and what technicians look for.



Technicians buy hand tools on a biweekly, if not weekly basis, Stinson notes, adding "and if they're not buying, then they're warrantying."

KEY TRENDS

As vehicle components continue to progress, the evolution of hand and specialty tools closely follows. In addition to tools being created, or redesigned, to assist technicians' work more efficiently, there has also been a continual shift across the spectrum, regardless of new parts, and that is to help technicians work efficiently.

This includes manufacturers taking a closer look at improving ergonomics as well as decreasing pain points when having to work in notso-comfortable, awkward tight spaces.

A better grip

Having a good grip on a tool is essential for obvious safety concerns. But just as importantly, a good grip benefits the user in more ways, especially if it's a tool used frequently.

"Ergonomics now play a great

role in today's hand tools," says Gray Hendricks, executive vice president of sales, marketing, and product development at Titan Tools.

One example now common in the market, he notes, are tools with handles that provide a better grip to decrease user fatigue while still providing the ability to do the task at hand, such as screwdrivers removing fasteners that may have once been damaged or required an impact driver to remove.

With the trend now focused on the grip and ergonomics, tool manufacturers are spending more time thinking through the ergonomics of their tools, says Chris Sanford, vice president of sales for SK Tools.

"What it comes down to is you want as much torque as you can with as little strain on your wrist and arm," he says.

Andre van Lagen, sales manager for North America at Mueller-Kueps also agrees, adding that the material used in the handles has been a focus when it comes to technician comfort.

Last year, Mueller Kueps launched its Heavy Duty Duo Handle Pry Bar, No. 276 343V2, which features not one, but two ergonomic, soft-touch, and hammer-resistant handles. By having two handles, the pry bar allows for two-handed use for not only safety, but also comfort.

Whether it's the size and shape of the handle, the material used to construct the handle, or the coating covering the handle, these are just a few ergonomic features worth bringing up with your customers.

Too close for comfort

Working in tight spaces is inevitable for technicians, especially as vehicle components continue to advance. To help ease pain points, hand and specialty tools manufacturers are always looking for ways to address this issue.

To reach extremely tight spaces, SK Tools developed X–Frame ratcheting wrenches which feature an arc swing as low as 1.7 degrees. The ratcheting wrenches use six pawls, two of which engage at any given time, resulting in 216 positions. Additionally, with its I–beam handle, force is distributed evenly for strength and durability.

Titan Tools recently reengineered their traditional style high tooth count ratchets to allow technicians to generate more torque by making the tools longer. By already having a high tooth count – thus, minimizing the sweep – technicians will not have to sacrifice the overall torque that the ratchet can now handle.

Stinson's top 5 selling hand and specialty tools

- 3/8" ratchets
- 3/8" deep and shallow sockets
- Screwdrivers
- · Hex and Torx bit socket sets
- Impact sockets

Another example is Cal-Van's 45-degree Universal Hose Clamp Pliers, No. 58. The pliers are designed to provide better access to hose clamps than standard pliers in difficult-to-reach areas, such as coolant tank ventilation line clamps, radiator hose clamps, and transmission cooler lines. The pliers

feature a special tip to grip almost any hose clamp from any direction. Additionally, with its angled head and extralong reach, the pliers can access some of the most obstructed clamps.

GEARING UP YOUNGER TECHS

For mobile tool dealer Stinson, it's more of the younger techs who are purchasing hand tools on his truck. Not only are they buying to build their inventory, but they buy to have the "latest and greatest," he notes.

What hand tools are best for young technicians starting out?

Although it really depends on their role within the shop, new/young technicians should have a good set of ratchets, sockets, wrenches, screwdrivers, magnetic pick-up tools, mirrors, and oil filter

wrenches, Cal-Van Tools' Vice President of Sales and Marketing, Matt Kenny says.

SK Tools' Sanford would also add extensions, various pliers (such as solid joint, tongue and groove, and retaining ring pliers), pry bars, scrapers, a torque wrench, punches and chisels, and hex keys.

"For a new technician, there are a lot of good starter sets out there," Sanford says.

However, with many to choose from, Sanford advises when looking to buy a starter set, they should build their practice strategically. For example, a 143-pc set may be more effective than an 850-pc set.

The 850-pc set may sound exciting and all-encompassing but might not make financial sense for a young technician to take on right away.

"That 143-pc set is just as effective for a beginning technician," Sanford says. "They then can add as they are financially able. But if they are not careful, they can rack up thousands of dollars in debt and be paying on that for years."

UPGRADING SEASONED TECHS

When it comes to his more seasoned customers, Stinson notes that many of them often warranty out what they already have, but that's not to say that upgrading their hand and specialty tools from time to time is uncommon.

"A lot of them already have what they need, but that's when the new stuff comes into play," he notes. "They're always looking for new and improved ways of doing things. So, if you can provide them with a new and quicker way, they're going to buy."

Since tools are constantly evolving, it makes sense for a professional technician to always be aware of tools that will enable them to be more effective, Cal-Van Tools' Kenny says.

"If something allows a technician to turn a 30 minute job into a 15 minute job, and they do that job often, then it's obviously a good investment on their part to be able to complete jobs faster."

SELLING TIPS

When it comes to making the sale, price will obviously play a factor. However, it's important to note that when it comes to hand tools, quality should be at the forefront.

"For technicians who use their tools ten to 12 hours a day, they want a tool that's not going to break, chip, or fail," SK Tools Sanford says. "To me, it's all about a quality tool."

"It's not worth buying things twice," Cal-Van's Kenny adds. "Quality is important, especially if they want this to be their profession."

The same holds true for specialty tools, even if technicians only use the tool on a few occasions.

"Where people stray is if it's for one use," Sanford says. "It's easier to become more price driven, [however] quality still holds. Quality is still the number one consideration. You still want it to do the right job."

Keeping your truck well stocked with hand and specialty tools and putting the tools in your customers' hands are key to making the sale.

"People like to touch and feel before they buy and if you have it readily available now, you're more likely to close the sale," Titan Tools' Hendricks says.

"Mobile tool distributors have a key role," SK Tools' Sanford adds. By visiting shops on a regular basis, they can put the tools in the technician's hand to get a feel for how it works, he notes. "I think that's the key when selling hand tools."

Our experts also recommend that dealers demo the tools.

"Demo, demo," Cal-Van's Kenny stresses. "Show people what the tool does."

Whether that's showing them in person or taking your own video in a shop or at home, Kenny suggests. If selling tubing cutters, for example, take a piece of brake tubing into a shop and show the technicians how it works and why it makes jobs easier.

For tool dealer Stinson, when making the sale, you must also "sell yourself."

"That's going to be the biggest thing because technicians can get their tools anywhere, so they are actually buying you and not the tool," Stinson says. "They are buying you and what you do for them."

Especially when it comes to hand tools. These tools can sell themselves in most cases, Stinson notes. "If you don't provide a good service for your technician as far as after the sale, such as how the warranty goes, then the tools are just tools."

A key piece of advice passed down from his father and what Stinson is hoping to drill into his son, who has recently joined him and is running his own route, is that "if you don't service what you sell then what you sell is no good."

His motto is, "You have to be able to backup what you sell." \bigcirc

Tesla service and repair

Experience the cutting-edge technology of Tesla vehicles and prepare to deliver proper service and support.

esla vehicles have been in the market for several years now and you may have already had one or more visit your service facility. Nevertheless, there are about 1.7 million EVs on the road in the U.S. and according to Electrek. com, over two-thirds of those are Teslas. I strongly believe that these vehicles are revolutionizing the way cars are built and serviced, but it's all not positive. As an owner of one of these machines, I've seen some interesting trends and feature changes with these vehicles. So, let's dive in and take a closer look.

As far as service goes, Tesla vehicles are generally considered to be relatively easy to work on. They are designed with long-term reliability and minimal maintenance in mind, and many of the maintenance tasks that are required can be done by using a few basic tools.

There are also more complex maintenance tasks that may be required, such as diagnosing and repairing issues with the electrical system. These tasks may require specialized tools and knowledge, which is where the service professional comes in. On a side note, most Tesla owners are more connected and aware of how their vehicles operate. Anyone considering stepping in to provide service on these vehicles will greatly benefit from possessing a higher level of knowledge of Tesla vehicles. Hopefully, this article will provide a jump start and encourage you to learn more about these cool cars.

Overall, the level of difficulty in servicing a Tesla vehicle depends on the specific task that needs to be performed, as well as the skills and experience of the technician doing the work.

Before you dive in, note that Tesla's new car warranty it currently offers for its vehicles covers the following areas:

- The battery pack and electric drive components are covered for eight years or 100,000 miles (160,000 km), whichever comes first.
- The remaining vehicle components are covered for four years or 50,000 miles (80,000 km), whichever comes first.
- · The paint and finish are covered for four years with no mileage limit.
- Corrosion perforation (rust-through) is covered for six years with no mileage limit.

Keep in mind that these warranties may vary depending on the specific model and location and are subject to change.





It is always a good idea to consult Tesla's website for the most up-to-date information on warranty coverage.

SERVICE MODE - HOW TO ACCESS THE DATA WITHOUT **ANY SPECIAL TOOLS**

Tesla recently opened access to the basic service mode within their vehicles to anyone via a hidden activation feature. Prior to this, access was geo-fenced, meaning that it could only be activated when the vehicle was within a specific geographic area such as a Tesla service center. This is good news for independent shops because this was a significant barrier for anyone attempting to properly perform a task such as a wheel alignment.

One thing to remember is that although one has access to these options, special care should be taken in order to avoid something going wrong. I recommend that if you're going to carry out actions, you do so with advanced knowledge acquired through study and attending technical training.

Additionally, activating 'Service Mode' does not provide access to all service modes. You will need to have a subscription to the Tesla Toolbox Software that will allow you to activate 'Service Mode Plus,' which will provide access to additional resources. Access to service information, however, is now

available at no charge, all you need to do is sign up on Tesla's website at service.tesla.com.

To enter service mode from the software page, "longpress" on the vehicle model name for about five seconds. Once you release, you'll be presented with a login screen. Enter 'service' and then you'll be presented with a warning screen you'll need to acknowledge in order to activate. Once you're in you'll see a red border added to the display screen with various options.

If there are issues to address, you'll see a message at the bottom of the screen with the number of active service alerts you should be aware of. Touching the 'Service Alerts' button will present you with a list and their visibility levels (Figure 1).

WHEEL ALIGNMENT

Did you know that a Tesla vehicle can alert the owner or service technician if it requires a wheel alignment? The Tesla vehicle's onboard computer continuously monitors the performance of various systems, including the suspension and steering, to detect any issues that may need attention. If the vehicle's wheels are out of alignment, the computer may detect unusual tire wear or handling characteristics and alert the owner or service technician through the vehicle's onboard diagnostics system or via the Tesla mobile app.

However, when you are in service mode you can pull up the chassis tab and have a look at the overall applied offset, which is what the system has arrived at after monitoring certain data parameters to detect a vehicle tracking issue. You will not receive a notification until there is a very large offset. I've inspected several vehicles and have found many them in the 2-3 degree range as shown in Figure 2. I've personally aligned many of these cars and have taken the learned offset inside of 0.4 degrees.

Performing a proper alignment should be done as recommended by the service manual, which is with 300 lbs of ballast added to the vehicle and adjusted to achieve the ride height specifications (Figure 3).

As with most vehicles today, not all angles are adjustable through conventional means however the service manual states the following:

"The Model 3 and Model Y vehicles do not have dedicated adjustment points for camber and caster. Instead, camber and caster are adjusted by manipulating the suspension lash and slop. The real-world accuracy of these adjustments is achieved by installing ballast bags to simulate the presence of a driver and front passenger. Performing this service procedure without ballast bags compromises the real-world accuracy of the adjustments."

There are options as some aftermarket companies are now offering solutions for achieving proper alignment angles. We have begun installing components offered by a company called Unplugged Performance located in Los Angeles. We've seen a few Model 3's and Y's requiring rear camber adjustment and their replacement control links work well (Figure 4).

DIAGNOSTICS

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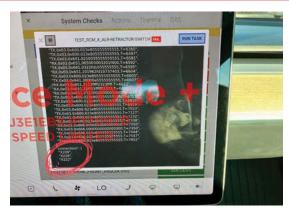


Figure 5 - Connectors of interest

From what I've observed thus far, Tesla's service information doesn't really have any diagnostic flow charts. However, when you're chasing down a service alert and running actions, you may be presented with connector numbers (Figure 5) where you would then look at service information, wiring diagrams, and connector locations (Figure 6).

Tesla's wiring diagrams may take a little getting used to. I recommend taking some time to study the initial pages on any

of their current diagrams to learn more about the legend. A lot of information is shared there that can help you navigate the wiring diagrams with more efficiency.

When you're within the Toolbox application running on your PC or laptop, oftentimes you'll find contextual links taking you right into the service information. However, there are features within service information that (as of the writing of this article) are not available to the aftermarket, such as the 'Interactive Schematic Tool.'

CASE STUDY

I own a 2018 Model 3, and I recently had a service issue related to the thermal management system. I was never alerted to the issue via the publicly visible notifications. When I entered 'Service Mode,' I was presented with the following error shown in **Figure 7**.

I proceeded to look in 'Service Information' for any testing info and there was none. The only support provided was in the description shown on the screen, "Check coolant valve harness and/or replace actuator."

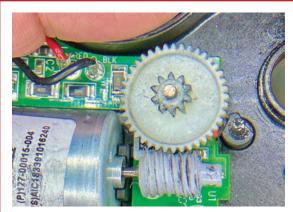


Figure 8 - Five-way coolant valve stripped gear

I checked the harness connector, and all looked fine, so I ordered a new actuator and replaced it. After replacement, I performed a cooling system bleed procedure where the fiveway valve went through a calibration routine resulting in the error message disappearing. I decided to do a post-mortem on the five-way valve and found the failure (Figure 8).

HIGH VOLTAGE SYSTEMS

Hybrids have been around for about two decades and high voltage (HV) training has been available for quite some time, so I will suggest that if you haven't had proper HV training you do so ASAP if you're going to be servicing any of these systems. The HV tab in 'Service Mode' offers quite a bit of information

about the HV system (Figure 9). Always refer to the latest service information when performing service on Tesla vehicles.

COMFORT SYSTEMS

Tesla vehicles use either R-134a or R-1234yf for their refrigeration systems with newer vehicles utilizing a heatpump system which brings a new level of complexity to the refrigeration loop. Performing system service on these systems will require the technician to enter 'Service Mode' and prepare the system for service. As mentioned earlier, reference the latest service information before service. Regarding the heat-pump system, a recent software update to the 'Service Mode' menu provides a highly verbose view



of the overall system where the technician can operate various modes and observe the refrigerant flow, temperatures, and pressures (**Figure 10**).

Cabin air filters are a service item we perform regularly not only on Teslas but all vehicles. In addition to that, we also recommend performing an ozone sanitization treatment service using the TEXA AIR2 SAN unit (**Figure 11**). This is a service we sell a lot of and is highly effective. All my employees also perform this service on their own vehicles as well.

GET TRAINED

Although we've touched on several areas, there's still a lot more to be aware of on these vehicles. However, service training and knowledge will go a long way in developing a higher level of awareness of Tesla vehicles.

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A new lease on life

After about a year on his tool route, this Cornwell Tool dealer got COVID-19 and was not given much chance to survive. Fortunately, he pulled through.

ornwell Quality Tool distributor Jon Bachand spent many years as an RV technician and fabricator. But upon advice from his tool dealer then, he decided to try the mobile tool business.

After about a year into his journey as a tool dealer in the Lakes Region of New Hampshire, Bachand got COVID-19. While many cases of the virus are reportedly mild, Bachand got a severe case that sent him to the emergency room, where he was admitted to the hospital immediately.

"I got COVID and went into the hospital in October 2021," he recounts. "I basically died four times and was in an induced coma. My wife continued to run the business and kept things going while I was in the ICU."

Bachand says he was laid up in the hospital for 12 weeks and was not given much chance to survive, but fortunately, he pulled through.

FAMILY TIES

Bachand's son Jonathan, who is also a Cornwell dealer, and his wife Laura were covering his tool route. In total, Bachand was out of work for about nine months, and doctors feared he might not be able to return to work for a long time, if at all.

"Cornwell stood behind me and helped me as much as they could," he says. "My wife actually ran the business while I was in the hospital. She'd go on the road and visit shops, and she took care of the warranty stuff."

Bachand's son also helped his father by delivering tools to people on his days off, and he and his mother collected money, too. "[My family] wasn't sure I was going to make it, so they signed over the lease on my first truck to another dealer," he reflects, saying that his family was starting to help the other dealer because they weren't sure if he was going to be able to come back to work.

GOING BIG

Bachand was released from the hospital on Jan. 1, 2022, and by the end of the month, he had already ordered a new truck. "I ordered a Freightliner M2 through Tim Herr, and he thought it'd be done by the beginning of May. And May came, and I still had no truck. So, Herr sent me a loaner truck, an MT45, to get me back to work because it would be another two to three months for the M2 to be finished."

Having survived such a rough bout with COVID-19, Bachand figured that he would go big this time.

"I figured if I survived COVID, I wanted to come back and come back big. I had a loaner truck for four or five weeks and got a call that they had a Kenworth that had financial issues and was available. I could have it in three weeks with the same wrap I was going to do on the M2 and almost the same design [as the Freightliner]."

Bachand says he is very grateful for everyone who helped him while he was out with COVID-19.

"Tim Herr went out of his way to send me a loaner to use for free," he says. "Everyone's been great. My district manager, they all really helped out through the whole ordeal."

Even though he is back to working full days, Bachand still has some effects from the virus.

"I'm still winded and stuff," he admits. "[And] I still have a lot of side effects that will take years to overcome."

While the virus may have taken its toll, it didn't win. Bachand says that he expects his tool route to be back up to 250 customers by this summer.





















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Selling Against Number One

Somebody is number one, and it is not always you. It's how you deal with it that sets you apart.

know you have a truck full of great products, but alas, each of those products is not the best in each product class. In each category or subcategory, there is some manufacturer with a better product or one that is at least perceived as the best. Whether it is an impact wrench, screwdriver, pliers, storage, or hardtoe shoes, somebody is No. 1, and it is not always you!

When this happens, do you just fold up your tent and not try to sell your version? No way! You still need to make a living. Look at the chart on the next page from Kelley Blue Book highlighting estimated pickup truck sales in 2022.

Not surprisingly, the Ford F-150 continues to be the No. 1 truck at an estimated 787,422 units. In fact, the F-150 Lightning was just announced as the 2023 Truck-of-the-Year by Motor *Trend.* Yet, when you look deeper, at the second through eighth-ranked trucks, these manufacturers sell 2,237,197 units.

Even though the F-150 is No. 1 in units, it is only 26 percent of the total truck market, leaving 4 percent for everybody else. Even Cadillac has a pickup priced over \$100,000!

Let's talk about how to successfully approach this situation and sell what you've got when your product is not No. 1.

First and most importantly, learn everything you can about your main competitor's product. Primarily because the more you know about their product, the better you can compete, and secondarily when a prospect makes some outlandish claim about No. 1, you can graciously help them with the correct information.

"I think if you look at the towing capacity on a base F-150, the rating is 14,000 lbs, not 24,000 lbs."

"It might sound nice that the XYZ angle grinder has 16,000 rpms, but actually, most grinding wheels are only designed for under 13,000 rpms."

FEATURES AND BENEFITS

List the features of the competitive product and compare your product to theirs. List them all since knowing even the smallest detail about the competition can help you close a sale.

Next, decide and write down what the benefit is of each of these features from a user's point of view. Include in your list both your benefits and theirs. Remember that a benefit is what each feature means to the user. Not what is important to you, but to the person using the product.

Often at the end of this exercise, you will discover that feature-for-feature, your product is equal to or even better than numero uno. Perhaps they are No. 1 because they have three times as many jobbers on the road than your brand or they just do more advertising.

Since you are now an expert on both your product and theirs, you can put together a superior presentation and close more sales.

PUTTING IT ALL TOGETHER

Put your demonstration together in logical order presenting your product features and benefits in order of usage. Build up to the big points as you go. This way, you will get your prospect thinking positively about your product on the less important points. This helps when the points where you may not be the product leader come up, so you at least have a good feeling started.

Where your product isn't the leader, be prepared to disarm it. Let's say the leading cordless impact wrench has 1,400 ft-lbs or torque, and yours has 1,000 ft-lbs. Theirs is \$295, and yours is \$250.

The presentation might go like this: "The 500 ft-lb units are mostly for DIY users. As a professional, your selection should be made based on the work you do. Don't you think?"

"Since you work primarily on passenger vehicles and light trucks, your

needs should probably be in the middle somewhere. You probably don't need the most powerful unit that has the highest price. Do you?"

You walked the prospect through the facts on ft-lbs and what the market offered. You also explained why the product you offered would satisfy the prospect's needs, and they agreed. Why buy an F-350 when you are only hauling bags of mulch for the garden on dry roads? Much of your success in selling against No. 1 is your attitude and how you approach the situation. If you go at it with your tail between your legs, your prospect will see through you in a heartbeat. Yes, your product may not be the market leader, but it is also not a piece of crapola either. Present your product with the same enthusiastic system as you would any of your products using the tried and true: Feature, advantage, benefit, trial close method followed by the feature, advantage, benefit, close.

Now, go sell something!

hough Cornwell Quality Tools distributor Dave Edwards has only recently reached his twoyear anniversary of selling tools, he knows the keys to continued growth for his business — time management, interacting with customers, and consistency.

SEEING SUCCESS

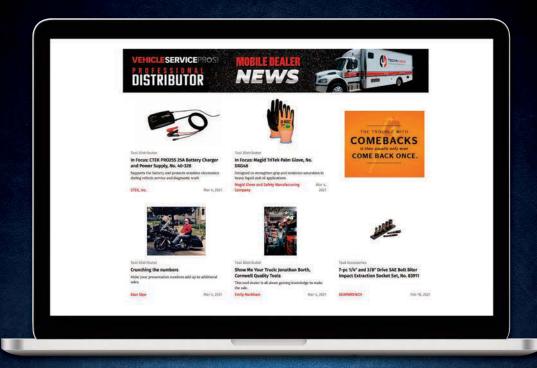
