
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Keep holding on










OEM and aftermarket scan tools increasing your situational awareness

The different tools on the market all have their strengths and weaknesses, and technicians need to be aware of each tool's capabilities.

remember one of the very first times I used a scan tool. It was on a 1982 GM vehicle equipped with the Computer Command Control system. At the time, these new layers of technology presented the dawn of a new era and interesting challenges. I began to imagine how this was going to change the way the technician would be addressing certain vehicle anomalies and what the future of automobile service was going to look like. Although the data stream was very cool, I had no idea as to how this information was being transmitted and displayed.

I remember trying to connect the same tool to another manufacturer and discovering that this operation required different adapters and software cartridges. Once I connected, I was disappointed to find that the live data stream found on the GM vehicle was not available on another domestic

OEM. My disappointment, however, was primarily my own fault for not having the proper service training on that vehicle system. At that point in time, I realized that I needed to acquire and consume as much training as I possibly could, and to this day, that hasn't stopped. Reflecting on


Figure 1 - Ford diagnostic and repair software.

this I can honestly say that we have come a long, long way.

SERVICE TECHNICIANS

Service technicians need to have a good foundational knowledge base around how a particular scan tool works and what the limitations are. For example, some tools may be very quick to connect to a vehicle and access the specific data the technician is laser-focused on. However, that specific tool may not be good at performing other functions, such as running a full vehicle scan or health check and produc-


ing a comprehensive report. Some tools are excellent at logging every action performed on the vehicle, which can be used to document how much time went into the analysis on the vehicle, in addition to providing module part numbers and software version levels (Figure 1).

The different tools on the market all have their strengths and weaknesses, and technicians need to be aware of each tool's capabilities in order to get to the bottom of a problem. Some tools can only read generic OBD-II standardized information, which might be fine, however, there could be more generic data the tool can't display. The same goes for tools possessing the ability to display OEM proprietary data: Some are more capable than others and your mileage may vary (more on that later).

CONTROLLER AREA NETWORK (CAN)

Beginning with 2008 models, the CAN protocol was mandated for all passenger vehicles and light trucks sold in the United States. This standard was implemented to help unify data communications between the various modules or nodes populating the vehicle. At the time, most vehicles only had a handful of modules sharing data across this network. Back then, many of the legacy scan tools were unable to communicate with the new CAN standard unless hardware and software changes were implemented. Today, however, vehicles coming off the assembly line possess dozens of modules which may not all be on the same network or communicating using the same protocols. In order for communication between them to take place, specialized modules are equipped with the hardware and software that allow them to act as a gateway device. These gateway devices are often tasked with translating data communicating on one protocol and servicing it up on another. This is where the service technician's knowledge of the various network topologies provides an advantage during troubleshooting events.

Also, due to the Right to Repair legislation passed in Massachusetts several years ago, vehicles built since 2018 are



more accessible than ever. All a service technician needs are a compliant J2534 interface, such as those offered by Drew Technologies (now Opus IVS), and a computer meeting the specifications outlined by the OEM. Armed with those items they will be able to purchase a subscription to access the vehicle using OEM software. Additionally, many of the operations such as reprogramming and advanced driver assistance systems (ADAS) calibrations are readily available as well. Furthermore, access to secure areas of the vehicle may require additional credentials, such as a Vehicle Security Professional (VSP) license issued through the National Automotive Service Task Force (NASTF).

EVOLUTION OF OBD-II

Since its introduction back in 1996, the OBD-II standard has evolved. Some of the features we typically rely on, including Mode\$06, Mode\$09, and Mode\$0A, were not always around or implemented in the same way. Take Mode\$06, for example. This mode is useful for examining how the onboard monitoring system is grading performance of the various onboard diagnostic routines, but it has its limitations. This information can only be fully

leveraged if the technician is equipped to master using it.

SECURITY

Even prior to the implementation of CAN, the ranking of security was not remarkably high for many OEMs. Today, we are witnessing huge movements by many of the OEMs focused on adding layers of protection barriers to these networked systems, which is understandably necessary. Given the federal mandate driving OBD-II, access to the generic operations cannot be blocked by these security measures. For the rest of the vehicle, however, we are starting to see more driver assistance systems that can support semi-automated driving support operations with the eventual goal of moving the vehicle to a fully autonomous Level 5, according to the SAE J-3016 standard. The hardening of these systems is extremely important. Today, most of us have probably witnessed the decision by FCA (now Stellantis) to include a secure gateway on 2018+ MY vehicles. One of the primary drivers of this stemmed from the work of two "white-hat" hackers by the name of Chris Valasek and Charlie Miller. (For more information on this, refer to my column in the May 2021 issue.)

FCA worked with the folks behind AutoAuth to enable a trust factor solution. According to their website, "AutoAuth provides a service for independent operators to unlock vehicles to securely provide service to their customers. New vehicles will come enabled with the latest cyber security features to protect vehicle owners from cyber-attack. AutoAuth works with independent tool vendors to ensure the tools independent operators use to do their jobs are AutoAuth certified tools. This will allow independent operators to continue to service cyber enabled vehicles. AutoAuth provides the registration service and 'unlock codes' to Independent Operator's service tools to unlock vehicle gateways to perform day to day service."

SOFTWARE

While the generic OBD-II standard mandates access to emissions related information and operations, each OEM can implement additional layers of data tooling that they deem necessary for supporting their service operations. Most of these OEMs offer scan tool manufacturers the opportunity to license access to these layers so that they can be implemented accurately within their tools. However, some may choose to go the route of reverse engineering during the development of their tools. Service personnel must be aware that the OEM does not always produce error-free applications. In fact, I have personally witnessed events where the OEM tool failed to accomplish a task where an aftermarket tool had to be used to realize success. And of course, the inverse has been experienced as well. As vehicles become more and more software defined, unfortunately, these errors are to be expected.

DATA

Given the number of nodes on the vehicle and the vast amounts of data available, the diagnostic technician's knowledge and skill set must be at the highest levels. The modern technician must be able to interpret service information and engineering data when addressing vehicle faults.

Additionally, having some computer science knowledge can be highly beneficial. Some OEMs have incorporated service information right within their diagnostic scan tools through guided fault-finding operations. Some aftermarket tools are also offering similar operations as well (Figure 2). Nevertheless, technicians can benefit tremendously by staying tuned in to emerging trends and best practices through networking opportunities via communities, such as the Diagnostic Network.

In general terms, one diagnostic scan tool is likely not going to be enough unless you are only working on one vehicle carline. All tools have their strengths and weaknesses, and one must be able to recognize them in order to succeed. With the emergence of PC-based applications, multiple scan tool applications installed on a single machine may not be ideal and for some, may be impossible. With the growing focus on security at all levels, safe computing assessments should be implemented. An auxiliary vehicle power supply should be available and used especially when performing any programming/software updates.

The modern automobile is one of the most complicated devices most humans will ever interact with, and as the vehicle evolves into a software defined machine, the skill set demands of the technician will continue to evolve. In my opinion, next generation technicians possessing these unique skillsets will be in high demand well into the future.





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Servicing hydraulic braking systems

Addressing squeaky brakes, pressure loss, and other braking issues requires the right tools and equipment.

rakes are kind of like offensive linemen — they don't get noticed until they do something wrong. All it usually takes is a strange noise or an unfamiliar feel in the brake pedal to bring a responsible driver straight to your shop for a diagnosis.

VERIFY THE CONCERN, THEN CHECK THE CAR OVER

When diagnosing a brake concern, the critical first steps are the road test and the visual inspection, as with all diagnoses. The visual inspection is the most valuable diagnostic tool in your toolbox. Looking over the entire car, not just the system you're diagnosing, allows you to get a feel for the vehicle. You're never just repairing a system, you're repairing a vehicle.

You should always record the thickness of the brake linings first. OTC makes a real nice brake pad thickness gauge that allows you to get an accurate reading of the inboard and outboard pads without removing the caliper, and in some cases, the wheel. Press the tip of the pen-size tool against the brake rotor and pull the gauge finger against the brake pad backing (Figure 1). The results are easy to read and displayed in plain view.

PINPOINT THE CAUSE OF **SQUEAKY BRAKES**

When diagnosing a brake squeak, pay close attention to the surface of the rotors. Look for a sign that the pads might be hitting the ridges on the outer edges of the rotor. As a brake pad wears, sometimes the friction material will mushroom out from the sides of the pad and contact the ridge.

A shiny ridge is a sign that this could be happening. Examine the contact surface of the rotors. Any grooves that you see on the rotor that have transferred to the brake pads will cause a squeal. If the brake linings pass, you can resurface the rotor and clean up the brake pads with some 100 grit sandpaper; this should stop this type of brake noise.

I highly recommend using an on-car brake lathe when resurfacing rotors. Spinning the rotor on its axle or hub bearing makes for a much tighter cut. We use the Pro-Cut PFM 9.2 DRO. It's simple to hook-up, easy to move around the shop, and always produces a nice cut. On-car brake lathes save the time of having to remove frozen or labor-intensive rotors. They also allow the technician to stay in his bay rather than carry rotors across the shop to the brake lathe.

APPLY THE CORRECT PRODUCTS TO PREVENT BRAKE NOISE

High-quality silicone-based caliper slide grease should be applied to every place on a brake caliper where metal touches metal. This means caliper slide pins, anti-rattle clips, and the edges of the brake pad backings. Wheel bearing grease is too thick, and white grease is too thin. Using the correct lubricant will prevent a high percentage of brake noise complaints. Permatex Silicone Ceramic Extreme brake parts lubricant applies evenly without running or wadding up. This makes it possible to apply the grease only where you need it to be without it migrating onto the friction material.

Most quality brake pads come with a noise suppressing material adhered to the back of the pads. This is to prevent movement between the brake pads and the cali-

per, dampen vibration, and absorb noise during braking. This small amount of friction can create a loud brake noise. Products are available that can be applied to the back of the pads if they don't come with the pre-applied sticky stuff. Aftermarket noise dampening products are available as an aerosol spray or as a paste in a bottle or a tube. CRC Disc Brake Quiet aerosol spray works well because it sprays on evenly and dries quickly. It's crucial that the spray dries completely before installing the pads. Whichever product you choose to use, it's important not to install a brake pad with a bare metal back.

Alternatively, if you're diagnosing a low or drifting brake pedal, first check for an external leak. Not all brake fluid leaks present themselves as puddles in the driveway. Sometimes wetness around a caliper piston or brake fluid behind the master cylinder is enough to cause an issue at the pedal. Don't forget to pull back wheel cylinder boots and check for fluid that has bypassed the cup seals.

After determining there are no leaks, watch the calipers operate while an assis-

tant activates the brake pedal. Look for a piston that might be traveling too far before it contacts the inboard brake pad and the rotor. This is a common problem on rear calipers with an integral parking brake.

Check for excessive movement in the brake pedal before the pushrod contacts the master cylinder. I recently serviced a vehicle that was missing the nose that screws into the end of the master cylinder pushrod. This caused over two inches of excessive movement at the pedal.

USE BLOCKERS TO DIAGNOSE A PRESSURE LOSS

If your preliminary inspection shows no external leaks or mechanical failures, you're most likely facing an internal pressure loss in a component. The best way to diagnose this issue is by using blockers to isolate hydraulic components (Figure 2).

Start by removing both outlet lines at the master cylinder and replacing them with blockers. You must use a set of good-quality blockers. The smallest leak at a blocker will cause an erroneous result that could lead to the replacement of the wrong parts. I've been using a set of Thexton blockers for years. They stand up well to the brake fluid without corrosion, and they seal perfectly. The brake pedal should be rock hard with both master cylinder ports blocked. If the pedal moves, the master cylinder is either losing pressure internally or is harboring trapped air.

If the master cylinder passes, block off the outlet ports at the hydraulic control unit (HCU). The pedal should be hard

with the ports blocked. If an outlet valve is stuck open, you'll know it by how far the pedal travels. A hard pedal during this step means that the master cylinder and the HCU are not the cause of the low brake pedal, which means that the problem is at one of the wheels.

Remove one blocker at a time, reinstalling the line on the HCU. Whichever



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circuit causes the pedal to sink is the bad guy.

We had a Ford Escape in the shop with a low brake pedal concern. The pedal was up high and hard when blocking off the ports on the master cylinder and the HCU. We removed the HCU blockers one at a time and discovered that the pressure loss was in the circuit feeding the left rear wheel. We then removed the rubber brake line from the caliper and blocked it. The pedal was still mushy. We removed the steel line from the rubber hose and blocked it. The pedal came right up to solid. The causal part was the rubber brake hose. Under close examination, we found a soft spot in the hose that was ballooning under the pressure of brake activation. Maybe we should have found this during the visual inspection, but using the blockers took us straight to the problem.

The outlet lines on a HCU are usually very close together and hard to get a wrench on. Consider using a flare nut crowfoot set to remove the lines. A crowfoot enables the removal of a single line without having to remove others to gain access. The Sunex 9710M is a nice affordable 3/8 drive crowfoot set. They're small enough to fit between the lines, leaving enough room to get a good turn on the fitting.

USE A PRESSURE BLEEDER AS A DIAGNOSTIC TOOL

A stuck open outlet valve isn't the only way that a HCU can affect brake pedal feel. A stuck closed inlet valve will produce a brake pressure differential concern causing a hard pedal and a possible brake pull. The best piece of equipment to diagnose a brake pressure differential concern is a good brake pressure bleeder. A brake pressure bleeder keeps consistent, adjustable pressure on the brake system. This enables you to check pressures at the wheels, knowing that pressure at the master cylinder is persistent. A pressure bleeder allows you to open a bleeder valve and just let it flow. This is great when replacing brake lines. You can

push all the air out of a line with just one turn of the bleeder valve.

There's no need to purchase an expensive electric or pneumatic pressure bleeder. I've been using the Mityvac MV6840 hand-pumped pressure bleeder. The unit keeps a constant 30 psi on the system. It comes with adapters for most master cylinders, including a universal adapter that easily attaches with a chain. Leaky adapters can hinder your diagnosis and make a mess on your shop floor. I haven't had any issues with these adapters leaking.

You'll have no pressure at the wheel most of the time when an inlet valve is stuck in the closed position. I have seen fluid sneak past a stuck valve. So reduced pressure at the wheel could also be due to a stuck closed inlet valve in the HCU.

USE THE RIGHT EQUIPMENT TO BENCH BLEED A MASTER CYLINDER

Since we're talking about bleeding brakes, I'd like to emphasize the importance of using the correct equipment to bench bleed a master cylinder. One-way check valves are the gadgets that separate a good master cylinder bleeder kit from a bad one. We all know the basic master cylinder bench bleeding drill. Hoses are attached to the outlet ports with a threaded fitting, and the opposite ends of the hoses are submerged in brake fluid. As the piston is applied, fluid and air exit the master cylinder, fluid is sucked back in when the piston is slowly released. The problem is that air is also pulled back into the master cylinder bore during the backstroke.

The one-way check valves are placed in line between the threaded fittings and the hoses. They allow fluid and air to exit through the hoses while stopping anything from returning. The clear hoses allow you to see when the air bubbles stop, and only fluid is leaving the master cylinder. Thexton makes a variety of good master cylinder bleeding kits. The right kit for you depends on which adapters you need for the models you service. They all come with check

valves and tough clear hoses. Be careful that you don't run the reservoir dry when using check valves. Keep in mind that no fluid is getting pulled in to replace what you pushed out.

BUY EQUIPMENT YOU CAN TRUST

The steadfast rule in all automotive diagnoses is if you can't trust the equipment, you can't trust the results. Take the extra time and spend the extra money to get the tools you know you can count on. You'll surely see a high return on investment. 😵







Bar's Leaks Oil Seal OS-1

Reviewed by Lou Fort, lead tech at K.A.R.S. Inc. in Huntingburg, Indiana.

THE REVIEW:

Q: What kind of setup was involved before using the product?

A: The setup is to turn the engine off, shake the OS-1 well, remove the oil fill cover and pour the OS-1 in per dosage chart. On the next drive, let the engine run for 15 minutes to get a good mix of oil and OS-1.

Q: How was its packaging? Did it come with any accessories?

A: The product is in a plastic bottle and it came in a box, which really was not needed. The box is covered with information including a safety notice, warranty, and instructions for getting a \$5 rebate. The QR code found on the lid pulls up a link to Bar's website for the OS-1. The bottle has much of the same information along with usage and a dosage chart. No accessories are included.

Q: Was there a manual included?

A: There wasn't a manual but usage and dosage charts are on both the box and the bottle. I didn't have any trouble understanding any of it.

Q: What features did you like?

A: Bar's Leaks promises it will fix your leak or oil burning problem or your money back. The product is compatible with all types and brands of oil.

Q: Is there any way you could think to improve or add to this tool?

A: I am not a fan of the dosage recommendation. I rarely see a vehicle that



takes just 4.5 quarts at service

— this is requiring two bottles to be purchased for most applications. That being said, the bottle should have a measured viewing window on the side so you can see just how much product has been used.

Q: What types of jobs/repairs did you use this tool for?

A: My first patient was a 2002 Sienna with leaking seals all over. This one was extremely high mileage, north of 300,000 and had been obviously neglected. It came in for engine noise, not leaks. It was determined that VVT [variable valve timing] noise was present, but the owner declined any further inspection or repairs, so we serviced the engine and added Bar's Leaks OS-1. By the end of the test drive, the VVT noise had been greatly reduced and the valve cover leaks had stopped — amazing in my opinion.

Q: Have you used a previous version of this tool?

A: We have used different brands of magic elixir mixes to help out with all the different issues Bar's Leaks claims to remedy. We are currently a BG Products shop. I am not much of a chemist so I can't speak much to the differences in formulation between them all. I do know we get good results from the BG Products and don't see why we wouldn't get similar results from the Bar's Leaks. Like most, Bar's Leaks recommends usage at every service to continue to see results.

Q: On a scale of 1 to 10, how would you rate this tool overall? Why?

A: In all my years in the industry, I have used many Bar's Leaks products. This newest reformulated one shows how hard Bar's Leaks is working to improve and keep up with the times. I have read a lot of independent user feedback all of which were high ratings. I would easily give the OS-1 a rating of 10.

Lincoln Industrial 2-Speed 20V Li-ion PowerLuber **Grease Gun**

Reviewed by Phil Fournier, owner of Phil's Auto Clinic in Hemet. California.

THE REVIEW:

Q: How did the tool function as far as saving you time?

A: Very few late-model vehicles have grease fittings, so I took this tool to my son-in-law's farm where I used it on a 12-row sugar beet digger. The machine has 24 stainless hardened steel disks each with two grease fittings for a total of 48 grease fitting just on the front of the machine. The belts have multiple pillowblock style bearings each with its own grease fitting. Air-powered guns are nice, but out in the field, compressed air is not necessarily handy to the location of the machine. This grease gun is the answer! Additionally, with a hand grease gun, it takes two hands to pump. With this gun, one hand can be used to squeeze the trigger and the other hand to guide the grease tip onto the grease fitting.

Q: What kind of setup was involved before using the product?

A: Not much. The grease gun came fully assembled. The instructions said to charge the batteries for 12 hours before using it, which I did.

Q: How easy was it to use?

A: It's a simple device. With two speeds to shoot the grease, simply hold the trigger in until you're done pushing grease in.



Q: How was its packaging? Did it come with any accessories?

A: It came with two batteries, which was nice, and the 20V Li-ion battery was strong enough to grease the entire machine with one battery on a single charge. Very impressive! It also came with two spare grease tips and those are highwear parts. When they wear, the grease goes everywhere except into the bearing where you want it.

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

The Lincoln Industrial 2-Speed 20V Li-ion PowerLuber Grease Gun is engineered for maximum reliability. Its twospeed transmission delivers 3.5 oz. per minute in the lowoutput position and 10 oz. per minute in the high-output position. It features a redesigned, high-torque powerhead driven by an efficient, 20V, Li-ion battery. The two-speed motor delivers grease at up to 10,000 psi (690 bar) in both high- and low-output settings. The gun's three-point base keeps the tool upright and stable for easy handling without being bulky, reducing operator fatigue when lubricating simple-to-reach fittings. >> 98

Q: What features did you like?

A: The tool is reasonably lightweight and well-balanced for its size. I'm not very strong anymore but holding the gun with one hand while guiding the grease tip didn't strain my arm. It was far easier to use than a hand pump gun.

Q: Is there any way the tool could be improved?

A: Like every new grease gun, there is some trouble purging the air out of it. Since I didn't go through an entire tube of grease, I don't know if that trouble would reoccur each time a tube is replaced. I am hopeful that it won't. Also, the carrying case is very nice but no one is going to tuck that hose back into the holder. I'd recommend just a clamp to hold the gun and let the hose hang inside the case. 8

Tekmetric Shop Management System

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

The Tekmetric Shop Management System is a cloud-based platform that provides an easy-tonavigate workflow for the auto repair process and analyzes data in real-time to promote business growth. Owners, service advisors, and technicians can use Tekmetric to build repair orders, manage inventory, send status messages to customers' smartphones, perform digital inspections, and analyze key performance metrics. The system's built-in reporting tools offer insight into numerous KPI metrics, such as gross profit percentage, car count, labor efficiency, and year-over-year growth. >>99

THE REVIEW:

Q: What kind of setup was involved before using the product?

A: We had a couple of conference calls and then Tekmetric set up a demo scene of it, where you go in and start setting up all your preferences. They work with you to get all that correct and make sure everything in the background is how you want it. And then they set a date for you to go live. In the meantime, you can kind of play in there and build estimates. When you do go live, you're used to the system, so it makes it an easier transition.

Q: How easy was it to use?


A: Even for the people who have the hardest time understanding computers and electronics, it's a really easy system to grasp ahold of. With no training at all, you basically can come into this thing, watch a few videos, and be up and running.

Q: Was customer support included?

A: The great thing with Tekmetric is they have a question mark icon up at the top of the screen. And at any point in time throughout the day, you can click on it, and you can chat with them right there, or you can call in and get help.

Q: What features did you like?

A: I'm a multi-store owner, meaning I could be in Florida tomorrow but North Carolina today. If my guys have an issue, I can jump on this system in five seconds and be able to look at the same thing they're looking at and make real time deci-



sions right then. What I also like about this system is that it's more like a democratic process. If we want anything on this system, then we can vote on it. Tekmetric puts it up on a board, and if the other stores that are out there on the system vote on it, they use that to add new things and upgrades to the system.

And our customers absolutely love it. The transparency to them of being able to see pictures and videos of what's wrong with their car, so they know they're not getting taken advantage of, is hands down one of the best features of this whole system.

Q: Is there any way you could think to improve or add to this tool?

A: I would like an icon with the clock feature that allows me to make an edit of a person's time on a day that they're not there and be able to label it a sick day or vacation day.

Q: How does this tool compare to similar tools?

A: It doesn't compare — it blows them out of the water. The reality is with our old system (we'll just use my Huntersville store for instance) we've been dilly dallying with hitting \$23,000 to \$27,000 sales weeks. We're so close to that \$30,000 week, we can see it. We didn't change anything but our point-ofsale system, and within five weeks of changing over we had our highest sale volume in a week of \$35,000. So, we're instantly seeing a ticket average increase in each store.

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

The Sonic Tools NEXT Generation **Combination Wrenches** feature a stronger and more durable construction than the previous model, the company says. They are made from tough and durable Chrome Vanadium steel for long-lasting use and are resistant to rust and corrosion. The open end provides access to fasteners that are difficult to reach with a socket, while the box end is a 12-point design to quickly grip fasteners and provide multiple angles of attack. Sonic wrenches are backed by a lifetime warranty. >>100



THE REVIEW:

Q: How did the tool function as far as saving you time?

A: The offset of the boxed end of the wrench is helpful. There is more depth there which can be helpful if working with a recessed fastener.

Q: How has using this tool impacted your shop's profitability?

A: When compared to using another brand of combination wrenches, the offset boxed end is an advantage that can save you time.

Q: How was its packaging? Did it come with any accessories?

A: I received three wrenches. Each wrench had a plastic hanger which I assume is used for displaying the wrench in a retail store or in a distribution warehouse. They didn't come with any accessories.

Q: What features did you like?

A: I like that they're lightweight, have a

comfortable feel, and matte finish.

Q: Is there any way you could think to improve or add to this tool?

A: The lightness may give a user the impression that they might be made of a cheap material and will not be a longlasting product. If they do last, I don't have anything negative to say other than they may give a user the impression that they're made with less material and may not be a lifetime wrench in a professional environment. Also, when you see Chrome Vanadium engraved, laser etched, or embossed into a tool, it traditionally has meant that you have yourself a cheap tool. I would recommend removing that from the tool.

Q: What types of jobs/repairs did you use this tool for?

A: I was able to do several wheel alignments with the sizes of wrenches we received. I also used them to remove the PCV system on a Volkswagen for a visual inspection due to a valvetrain noise.

Q: How does this tool compare to other tools you've used like it?

A: These wrenches are lightweight and have a matte finish which makes the wrench comfortable in your hand. The offset box end can be helpful when working with fasteners in recessed areas. &



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




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1+1 = 1 huge box

Rusty Flake took his first Snap-on box and bolted on another of the same size to create a mega big-time box.

usty Flake's shop in Whiteland, Indiana, does pretty much everything, but he specializes in diagnostics. This means he needs a toolbox big enough to house his diagnostic equipment. His Snap-on box is 14.5' long and 6' high and has big drawers to fit his diagnostic tools. It has a built-in workstation, lights, and a stereo, and at one point, it even housed a microwave.

"It's nothing special by today's standards... Now you can buy boxes with lights and a stereo but when I bought mine, I never saw any that had this stuff built into it, so I just added that," says Flake, who is the owner of Advanced Automotive Diagnostics and Repair.

When the market crashed in 2001-02, Flake bought another bottom box that was the same size as his current toolbox and bolted the two together to make one huge box.

"It was very cost-effective at that time," he says. "But it just gets bigger and bigger as you go... It almost holds everything now."

Flake's box has six swivel casters and two fixed casters (so he can move it around a bit if needed) and a convenient side

locker. For added ease, he had the locks matched so all the doors and drawers can be opened with one single key.

Before 2002, Flake's box was half the size and he had a 4X4 closet packed full of equipment, an office brimming with tools, and three roll-around carts.

Today, Flake has his mega box but he still uses his four roll-around carts that house his most-used diagnostic equipment.

He also uses plastic blow molded cases for stuff that won't fit in his box but that he still needs to protect, such as leak detectors and a ball joint press.

Flake stores his SAE tools on the left and his metric tools are on the right side of his box. In his smaller drawers, he has his pliers on the left, job-specific pliers or plier-like tools on the right, and sockets go straight across. In the bigger drawers, he has his breakout boxes and his diagnostic equipment (other than the scopes, which are on his roll-around carts).

Flake says his favorite tools are all of his ATS equipment.

"I know almost everyone at the company, and they are just super nice people and you can't get better service than going to them," he says.

He especially likes his four ATS scopes and he is currently looking to buy another one — the eight-channel scope that is an "absolutely phenomenal unit," he says.

"They're extremely capable, they are very easy to use, they're constantly upgrading features on them, and they are quick, simple, and easy to grab," he says. "You hook up and you know if you got a connection — this will tell you you either have a signal or you don't."

When it comes to purchasing tools, Flake says the more expensive items, such as the scanners, scopes, and TPMS tools should be the shop's responsibility. For hand tools that are purchased by the technicians, they should get whatever works for their budget and is comfortable, then they can upgrade as they go.

"If a ratchet feels good in your hand, you're going to be able to work more efficiently with it," Flake explains. "The best one out there is the one you will use and the one you are comfortable using." &
