

Growling, howling, whistles, and wind

A vehicle's sound story starts at production and continues well into the bay.

Shh. Our vehicles are becoming quieter ... and drivers want to keep it that way. Emerging electric and autonomous systems are leading the charge (as well as presenting unique challenges) when it comes to new noise, vibration, harshness (NVH) standards in new-to-market automobiles. The idea is to make them quiet and keep them quiet for the duration of the vehicle's lifetime.

SAE International recently covered the topic of NVH at the design level in their June issue of Automotive Engineering. Here, I learned NVH detection is not just an aftermarket crusade; it really begins early on in vehicle development and starts with design.

Getting vehicles to an ideal noise level is no easy feat. Engineers are tasked with creating a quality sound and feel for drivers, which might include keeping the thrill of an engine growl to some extent while also tamping down nonessential sounds.

To achieve the desired level of noise, automotive engineers strip a vehicle down to its most basic components. They employ semianechoic and anechoic chambers to help understand OEMs' systems and improve performance in NVH. These 'quiet chambers' dampen sounds and help identify NVH band-aids present on vehicles' structures. The engineers may further research and use solutions to minimize NVH in today's vehicles, such as integrating what the company Material Sciences Corp. (MSC) calls Quiet Aluminum and Quiet Steel, both of which are expanding from use in body components to other applications, including powertrain pans to replace castings and composites.

"The autonomous vehicle sector is creating a ... new environment of noise and vibration solutions," says Bruel & Kjaer Automotive - Americas Director, Gary Newton. "As OEMs continue their vehicle-lightweighting crusade, vibration will increasingly have an impact on vehicle design and materials selection."

Acura now uses high-performance structural adhesives and sound-absorbing acoustic spray foam in 12 body cavities, which Automotive Engineering reports is a 15 percent increase (by surface area) in sound deadening material. Other sound 'helps' in use are triple door seals and acoustic-laminated glass.

Software-based toolsets and simulation tools for vehicle development and design come into play, too. Software may be paired with a steering wheel and pedals so drivers can experience sound and vibration data.

This month in Tool Briefing, contributing editor Barry Hoyland talks about NVH from the aftermarket perspective, specifically diagnosing NVH issues that present themselves in the repair bay (pg. 38). For shops, these types of NVH problems can be time-consuming to diagnose and can have a myriad of causes, including worn system components or wind passing over or through the vehicle. While today's diagnostic procedures and tools can help to isolate and locate noise, it's also essential to simply test and re-test these vehicles on the road, sometimes with another technician in the passenger seat.

Vehicles are becoming smarter, lighter, and quieter. This doesn't mean you won't still be working to isolate and fix the symphony of sounds that are driving your customers nuts well into the foreseeable future. **PTEN**





Diagnosing NVH

Understanding the different types of noises, what can cause them, and the appropriate methods to find the source are essential in diagnosing noise, vibration, harshness issues.

oise, vibration, harshness (NVH) issues can be time-consuming to diagnose. This is mainly because noise and vibrations can use the vehicle's structure (chassis) as an antenna to transmit the noise throughout the vehicle, making it difficult to pinpoint the exact cause of a noise.

Additionally, noises can be caused by worn components in just about any system or by wind passing over or through the vehicle. Let's start off by explaining different types of noises and their possible causes, then we will discuss the best tools to use to find the source of a noise.

As always, use your vehicle information source to determine if there are any technical service bulletins (TSBs) related to the issue the vehicle is having. You should also be aware that there are some excellent diagnostic procedures available for isolating and locating noise or vibration issues on a vehicle in ALLDATA's information database.

GROWLING OR HOWLING NOISES

Typically, a growling noise is caused by a worn bearing. If the noise occurs when the engine is running and the vehicle is stationary, it is due to an engine-driven component. The noise level may be constant or change with engine speed. Engine-driven components include water and power steering pumps, belt idlers and tensioners (including timing belt components), alternators, and air conditioning compressors. Some of these parts can be isolated by turning them off or removing a belt to determine if the noise is eliminated. In other cases, an electronic stethoscope, such as the Steelman EngineEAR, can be used to locate the source of the noise.

Use the stethoscope to listen to individual components in order to isolate the noise. The EngineEAR has the capability of adjusting the volume of the microphone. This feature, coupled with its noise reduction headphones and superb microphone, makes it much easier to identify specific noises.


If the growling noise is not present with the vehicle stationary, then the noise can become a little more difficult to locate. Rotational noises that are present with vehicle movement can be caused by bearings in the transmission, axles, hubs, or differential. These noises can also be caused by worn gears in the transmission



or differential, worn or mismatched tires, or even wheel or axle alignment problems. Isolating these noises can be difficult because noises can carry through to other components and many noises sound the same.

One thing that causes a technician to spend a lot of time with diagnosing noises is the time it takes to road test the vehicle in certain conditions to duplicate the noise. In many cases, a technician will need to drive the vehicle at a specific speed in order for the noise to be present. If a change is made to the vehicle, such as rotating the tires, in order to see if the noise changes, the road test must be performed again. Noises can also be difficult to locate because they may sound like they are coming from the rear of the vehicle when you sit in the front and the front of the vehicle when you sit in the rear.

At this point, I should remind you

when driving a vehicle, in order to diagnose anything, including noises, safety should be your number one concern. Utilizing a helper to drive the vehicle enables the technician to both listen for the noise and to operate any tools or equipment safely.

The best way to help limit the number of road tests is to detect the specific location of the noise. Our go-to tool to isolate the cause of noises is the Steelman ChassisEAR. We use the wireless model which utilizes a series of wireless microphone/transmitters that connect to the vehicle. These transmitters then allow the technician to listen to each signal either collectively or individually to determine the location of the noise. By understanding the location of the noise, it is much easier to determine the cause, thereby reducing the number of road tests to find the source of a noise.

Transmitters can be placed on each



corner of the vehicle allowing the technician to narrow down the area of the noise. For instance, place a transmitter on each front and rear strut or shock mount. If the noise is only detected by the rear transmitters, place a transmitter on each side of the rear axle housing, the transmission output housing, and the center of the differential. You are now able to determine by the location of the noise if it is caused by the transmission, differential, or by which axle bearing. If the noise is the same from each transmitter, it could be caused by a tire that is mismatched, worn, or has an aggressive tread design.

WHISTLE OR WIND NOISES

Wind noises may be caused by many factors, including window or door seal leaks, body seam leaks, or even external components such as roof racks or windshield wiper arms deflecting air across the body.

The first step in locating a wind noise is to obtain specific information from your customer about when the noise occurs. Many wind-related noises only occur at specific road speeds or conditions and may include factors such as whether the A/C is on or off. Second, perform a complete visual inspection of the vehicle. Look for loose or misaligned body or door panels, loose window seals, or obvious body damage. If nothing is noted with a visual inspection check your vehicle information source to see if there are any TSBs related to the noise complaint.

A road test will need to be performed to duplicate the noise. You must pay particular attention to even the smallest details and be prepared to make changes to the vehicle as you drive. Once you hear the noise, try making changes to the vehicle and listen for changes to the noise. Changes that can be made that may affect noise include blower fan speed, vehicle speed, opening a window, or taping off openings in the body or firewall.

If the noise does not change when either the fan speed changes or the window is opened, the cause of the



noise is most likely due to a misaligned or deformed body panel or even a roof rack crossbar that is causing air to create turbulence when passing by. Using the ChassisEAR may assist you in locating the source of the noise. It may also be useful to remove roof rack crossbars and observe components like wiper arms to see if there is movement while driving.

If the noise changes when air pressure within the vehicle changes, as with higher or lower fan speed or opening a window, then the noise is most likely caused by an air leak within the vehicle. One method to determine the source of an air leak is to install an ultrasonic leak detector transmitter inside the vehicle. Then, walk around the vehicle with the receiver, which will beep or flash a light when it detects a signal from the transmitter, allowing you to pinpoint the air leak.

Another method to locate air leaks is to use a diagnostic smoke machine. Place the vehicle in a bay with very little air movement. Roll up all the windows and close all the doors. Set the vehicle's blower fan to high, then walk around the vehicle with your smoke machine, blowing smoke at door and window seals. If you pass an area where the smoke is pushed away, there is air leaking at that point. This is caused by the positive air pressure in the vehicle (fan on and doors sealed) escaping to lower pressure outside the vehicle.

Over the years we have found many different noises - most of them caused by normal items such as tires, worn bearings in the engine, or drivetrain components. Some of the more difficult ones to detect only occurred during very specific conditions. Here are a few that come to mind.

• A 1980's era full-size Chevrolet that made a scraping noise only when pulling into the customer's driveway. We found that their driveway was on a steep slope and you needed to make a fairly sharp turn to get into it. When the customer accelerated the vehicle to get up the slope, the motor mounts were worn just enough for the fan to scrape the fan shroud.

Be sure to place the transmitter and microphone wire in a location away from moving parts and hot exhaust components.



- · Many vehicles that had motor mounts worn enough to cause exhaust components to rest on the body, which then would transmit engine noise throughout the cabin.
- A vehicle that had some air conditioning work performed, and then started making a humming noise off and on only when the defroster or A/C was on. We found the high side pressure hose was bent enough that

the aluminum tubing was resting on the evaporator housing. When the compressor cycled, the pressure in the hose moved it further into the case, which caused the noise.

- A vehicle that made a sound like water rushing through a tunnel. We found that someone had removed the thermostat, which caused the water flowing through the heater core to move faster, making the noise.
- · Numerous vehicles that have had noises or vibrations at idle caused by poor idle quality or speed. These were corrected by cleaning the throttle body and resetting idle adaptive strategies.

Some noises may be frustrating to isolate, and they can have some very interesting causes. But, with the right tools, they can also be very profitable to tackle. **PTEN**

OTC Heavy Duty Extendable Indexing Pry Bar

This master technician praises the tool's versatility and design.

THE REVIEW:

inding just the right pry bar for a specific job can be a dilemma in any shop, leading to wasted time and increased expenses due to stocking multiple bars, and the trial and error methods used when attempting to complete a task with a range of bars to choose from. Jeff Buckley, owner and master technician at My Father's Shop in Midlothian, Texas, provided a review of the OTC Heavy Duty Extendable Indexing Pry Bar, No. 7177, and said the tool solved this dilemma, eliminating the need for multiple bars.

"The biggest advantage is that because it is indexable, you can change the angle on the head; you don't have to dig through all your different pry bars to find the one that has the right angle for the job," Buckley says. "And because it's extendable, you can adjust it out to the length that you need. It's twice the length of normal pry bars ... and because it extends and is longer, it gives you more leverage. Most of the time with other pry bars, we grab a piece of pipe and stick it on the end of the bar, trying to make it longer. This tool gives you the leverage without having to use a bunch of force. You're not pushing as hard and you're not straining as much."

There is no setup required; the 7177 is ready to go to work right out of the box. There was no accompanying manual needed either, as Buckley attested to the tool's ease of use.

"It's not just a matter of how easy it is to use, but how useful that tool is," Buckley says. "It's extremely useful."

The tool's extendibility utilizes a push-button system. Buckley mentions there was no concern that the push button would hang in the way or that the tool would become crooked when extended. The indexable head on the 7177 was one of Buckley's favorite features.

"Most [pry bars] have a set angle," Buckley says. "I've seen a couple smaller ones that are adjustable, but they have plastic gears and teeth. [The 7177] has metal gears and teeth, so I'm not really worried about prying with it and that angle breaking loose."

"It's a really well-made tool; they thought about it," Buckley adds. "It's well manufactured."

The master technician says that the tool's weight is exactly what it needs to be, noting that it shouldn't be any lighter because it would begin to flex when prying. He says that there is no flex or give in

the bar, even when fully extended.

"When you extend it out and you grab it in the middle, it's not like you're trying to lift a heavy tool, even though it is a heavy pry bar," Buckley says. "You're not struggling to control or balance it."

My Father's Shop used the 7177 for a myriad of jobs, such as checking ball joints, moving lower A-Frames, and suspension and alignment work.

"There's another tool I have that will do lower A-Frames; it's just a long bar with hooks that will grab the frame," Buckley says. "But then that tool has to go over in the corner because it won't go in the toolbox. And it is designed for one thing, whereas [the OTC Heavy Duty Extendable Indexing Pry Bar] is a versatile tool that can be used in many different instances and it collapses down, so it fits right in the toolbox."

"[There is] really nothing I didn't like about it," Buckley says. "It's just extremely useful and handy."

This shop owner gave the OTC Extendable Pry Bar a high rating due to its versatility, design, and construction. Buckley affirmed the review, stating, "This one's going in my toolbox." **PTEN**

Legacy Manufacturing Flexzilla Air Compressor

"This is by far the quietest compressor that we've ever owned," the reviewer says.

THE REVIEW:

Things in the automotive business may be ever-changing, but the need for shops to have pneumatic tools will never change. "It's definitely a must-have tool," says Dennis Gregory about Legacy Manufacturing's Flexzilla Air Compressor with Silencer, 1-Phase, 2-Stage, No. FS05V0811. Gregory is the owner of Xtreme Unlimited, a repair shop in Prescott, Arizona.

"The biggest thing is the fact that it's very quiet ... I've owned probably ten compressors over the years, and this is by far the quietest compressor that we've ever owned," Gregory says, noting that whether the air compressor is in an enclosed space or not, the noise is never obtrusive.

When it came to setting up the air compressor in his shop, Gregory notes the process was actually quite simple. All he and his technicians had to do was place the compressor and perform a simple hook-up to tie it into the air system in the shop. The last part of the set-up was the electrical connection, which Gregory said most electricians can handle.

Not only was set-up easy, using the machine is a "no-brainer," Gregory says. "You turn on a switch." The manual the air compressor came with was also easy to understand with its wellwritten directions.



The compressor itself doesn't come with any accessories, but after purchasing it, Gregory did add a few things.

"As far as the unit itself, it comes ready to go. There's nothing you need to add. Here in our shop – just the way it's plumbed – [we needed to add] plumbing stuff. We [also] added a dryer to eliminate any water that gets into [the] air system," he says.

Another feature of the air compressor Gregory likes is how the machine is set up for servicing.

The Legacy Manufacturing Flexzilla Air Compressor with Silencer, 1-Phase, 2-Stage, No. FS05V08011, is designed to operate quietly in the workspace. > "Compressors are pretty simple things, there's not a lot to them, but down the road ... we will [have to] change the belts that drive the system, and it looks to me like it's going to be very simple compared to some of the other units I've had," he says.

> Since receiving the air compressor, Gregory guesses his shop has already put a couple hundred hours on it. The compressor has been used for custom Jeep modifications, custom fabrications, and a lot of early street rod manufacturing.

> Overall, Gregory is very happy with the Flexzilla Air Compressor. The only concern he had before purchasing the machine was needing to know the size of the fitting that comes out of the side that would tie into the shop's air system. With one call to Legacy, Gregory says he was quickly provided with the information he was looking for.

> "I wasn't on the phone a minute and had the question answered," he says.

> Although Gregory hasn't had the air compressor long, it has served him well thus far.

> "[This air compressor] has been as good or better than advertised," he says. "The quality ... is perfect." **PTEN**

THE REVIEW:

S ome tools are so basic most technicians don't give a second thought to how well they function. Take the air hose, for example. Most air hoses today take the same basic form that has been used in shops since pneumatic tools first came on the scene. And, most of them work ... well enough. Matt Fanslow of Riverside Automotive in

Red Wing, Minnesota, never paid much attention to his shop's air hoses. Then he tried the Prevost Flexair Hybrid Hose, and that all changed.

Fanslow says the Flexair pneumatic hose caught his attention by exceeding expectations he didn't even know he had, in several ways.

"We've [always] used the conventional hoses you would most often buy from parts stores and thought little of it," he says. "Over a year or so they'd crack, break, bulge, get very dirty, et cetera. We've had the Prevost [hoses] for a few months now. No signs of cracking or bulging; very easy to clean; they also lay prevost

nicely ... they don't kink or loop up while dragging around a vehicle."

Fanslow says he appreciates that the hoses are soft, meaning they lay flat on the floor without creating a tripping hazard. He also notes that being easy to clean is a very important factor; he is often frustrated with older air hoses that collect dirt, grease and grime, and leave marks on clients' vehicles when used in the interior.

An additional feature that Fanslow likes is the "extremely nice" fittings.

"They don't leak," he says. "They have push buttons on the side instead of the conventional collar you pull down to remove a pneumatic tool."

The technicians at Riverside

Automotive use the Flexair hoses for a wide variety of tasks and come away impressed with each use.

"[We use the hoses for] any task requiring the use of pneumatic tools or the ability to use directed air under high pressure," Fanslow says. "Adjusting air pressures in tires, removing rusted bolts that our cordless tools didn't have the torque to remove on their own, [using] air nozzles to clear off intake plenums prior to removal, et cetera."

The hoses came coiled in neat rolls with plastic straps and cardboard packaging. A manual was not included but is not really necessary for an air hose. Fanslow notes that some OSHA approved prevoS1 blow guns were included, and that the technicians at Riverside Automotive use them "all the time."

Fanslow says the hoses are so well liked by his technicians that they will actually walk past a nearby older hose just to go pick up a Flexair hose without even realizing it.

This makes him wonder, "Is it weird to love ... air hoses?" **PTEN**

THE REVIEW:

Channellock continues to provide top shelf, high quality tools with both their new 7" Diagonal Cutter, No. 4371 and 8" XLT Long Nose Pliers, No. 3181, says Lou Fort, lead technician at K.A.R.S Inc. in Huntingburg, Indiana. Fort was impressed when he used both types of pliers at his shop when performing repairs and maintenance work on cars and trucks.

Fort noted that the tools were very easy to use and said he couldn't find anything not to like about them.

Both tools, designed primarily for electrical work, are insulated for high voltage protection.

Although Fort didn't have an opportunity to use the tools on any hybrid or electric vehicles during the time he reviewed them, he has full confidence that both pliers would work well in that application.

Upon receiving the tools, Fort said they came in a clear, plastic clam shell that displayed product information such as part number, tool length, and their 1,000V protection rating on the front. On the back, additional features for each tool can be found such as laser heat-treated cutting edges and pipe grip design.

"One doesn't have to look hard to see that Channellock makes 'Made in the U.S.A.' with pride and meaning," Fort says.

Some key features Fort liked about the diagonal cutter and long nose pliers are that they are OSHA compliant for high voltage protection. He also appreciated the crosshatch pattern on the jaws of the long nose pliers, as well as the Xtreme Leverage Technology (XLT), a new feature that requires less force to cut than traditional high leverage.

Fort also enjoyed the different colored handles on both of the new tools. They are not the traditional Channellock blue, but instead are high visibility yellow and red, the universal standard for tools used in electrical work. The handles also have a hand stop built in, which the company says will keep users' hands a safe distance from the work.

Overall, Fort found both the Channellock 7" Diagonal Cutter and 8" XLT Long Nose Pliers are easy to use, high quality tools to have in the shop. **PTEN**

Automotive intel

Translating repair information to the diagnostic tools available.

nformation is a key topic of discussion at just about any roundtable regarding automotive repair. Sure, there is always the usual "can't find enough qualified technicians," but all in all, what makes a qualified technician qualified? It's the ability to utilize important information.

As with many different skilled trades, becoming good at your profession requires dedication and training in every aspect of the job, as well as a lot of practice, refresher courses, an abundance of reference materials, good observational skills, and the right tools.

When it comes to tools in our industry, there seems to be some disconnect between reference materials and the tools we use every day. Don't get me wrong, when it comes to good vehicle repair information, there are many sources available. For the most part, with very little practice most technicians are good at obtaining the correct information to diagnose and repair vehicles properly and efficiently.

However, when it comes to operating instructions on our tools, information seems to be somewhat thin, especially on one of our most used pieces of equipment, our scan tools. If you utilize factory (OE) scan tools, most manufacturers have built the tools for the dealership network where technicians that use them have been trained specifically on their use.

If you are an independent aftermarket shop or a technician that does not have a dealership background, you may find there are limited reference manuals for the operation of those scan tools. This lack of information can sometimes make it difficult to diagnose and repair



vehicles efficiently. In some cases, it may be worth considering an OE scan tool in addition to the more universal aftermarket ones, if for example, a specific vehicle make comprises 20 percent or more of the vehicles that come to your shop. Of course, you still need to evaluate the cost of the tool, training, and annual updates associated with an OE scan tool in order to calculate the ROI, especially considering it will only be used for one vehicle make, whereas an aftermarket scan tool can often be used for many.

Many of us probably have more than one manufacturer that reaches the 20 percent threshold and will require more than one OE tool, anyway. We also have a lot of other vehicles that would require a good aftermarket scan tool. Now we have another issue: some technicians are familiar and very proficient with a particular scan tool, but not as comfortable nor as effective with another. Some of this is easily overcome by training on the tool, while some of it is a little more difficult to cure due to differences in how aftermarket tools are programmed and supported.

In order to understand some of the issues, you need to appreciate the challenges scan tool manufacturers face. Almost every vehicle manufacturer has specific names for PIDS, modules, and bidirectional processes that are unique to their vehicles. When using an OE tool, the PID names and functions are consistent with the OE repair information – even more so if you have been trained

on the information and use of the tool.

Because every vehicle manufacturer has their own "language," it can be difficult for aftermarket scan tool manufacturers to integrate some tasks and information into an easy-to-use format for the technician. Additional challenges arise when the technician is forced to acquire repair information from an aftermarket source and use a scan tool, neither of which may be using terminology that is consistent with each other or the vehicle manufacturer.

Many aftermarket scan tools have renamed the OE specific module/PID/ bidirectional terms into a more generic terminology that they use for every vehicle their scan tool supports. This makes it much easier for technicians to use the tool and learn to become efficient with it.

Aftermarket vehicle information sources do much the same thing, make information more usable by naming procedures and tests similarly across vehicle lines to make it easier for technicians to find necessary information quickly, rather than to trying to find manufacturerspecific terminology.

When testing a vehicle with a scan tool, these challenges can cause diagnostic errors. Even though your scan tool is showing a perfectly good test result for a particular component or system, the readings may be in a different form, or in a lot of instances, not even close to what the repair information shows.

You might have to discern whether your scan tool's software doesn't align with the repair information or if you are misinterpreting the information. Some tool manufacturers are aware of this concern. I asked Danijela Haskin, product manager for diagnostics at Bosch, about this discrepancy.

"Bosch licenses data directly from the OEMs and develops other coverage to compliment OE service procedures," she says. "As an example, this is why you'll find Bosch diagnostic tools use the same module system names, rather than putting them in generic terms. This helps when referencing OE information."

Information and test results allow a technician to pinpoint the problems



faster and easier than they could without such data. Having that information is the key to a successful diagnosis.

"The features available on our tools are those specific to that electronic control module for that particular manufacturer you're working with and are not necessarily relatable to a similar engine from a different manufacturer," says Bruno Gattamorta, vice president of diagnostic sales for Cojali USA. "Our tool is developed based on OEM standards, meaning that if the OEM proceeds in a certain way to achieve its tests and results, we will provide the same."

"We match the OE service procedure found in most repair information sources," says Michael Flink, commercial sales manager and trainer, North America, at Autel. "The intent is both to give better overall coverage and to make it easier for the technician to follow an OE service procedure. Autel also updates throughout the year, allowing it to keep up with those changes from the OEs."

THE GOOD TECHNICIAN

This is where the ingenuity of a good technician shines best: That is, taking the raw data offered in the repair manual or scan tool and somehow converting it into useable data that conforms to the tools available. A lot of times, it's a simple matter of converting newton

meters to pounds per square inch or Celsius to Fahrenheit. Other times, it's a game of wits between the technician and the repair information. But, adapting the scan tool and repair data into useable information combined with solid diagnostic procedures is the key to successful repairs.

A long time ago, I adopted a policy in my shop where any type of diagnosis had to be verified by performing the diagnostics using two entirely different methods and cross-checking the results between the two procedures. One method could be a scan tool, while the second method could be a multimeter. If the test results were verified by the results of the previous test, the job was a go.

This not only ensured a more accurate diagnosis but also gave the technicians a chance to explore new and innovative testing methods they may not have been as familiar with. For the most part, it avoided the dreaded comebacks and the ever-annoying (and present) technician dilemma of the "well, that isn't it" scenario.

SCAN TOOLS: WHAT IS THE TECHNICIAN LOOKING FOR IN A TOOL?

The number one thing I look for in a scan tool is coverage. First, a scan tool needs to have the coverage for the type of vehicle I'm most typically going to be working on, with access to as many forms of the tests and bidirectional controls similar to the factory tool, if not better. Good coverage for a few other manufacturers' vehicles on the same scan tool is a plus. This avoids having to relearn different terminology and computer pages that are likely to differ from one manufacturer to another.

Graphing and pinpointing sensor data is a great feature, too, especially when it is easy to use and understand. Whether using a factory or aftermarket tool, it comes down to cost, updates, and the number of years covered by that manufacturer.

Things like data speed and touchscreen resolution come to mind as additional concerns, as technicians don't always work in ideal lighting conditions. Autel's Flink had this to say on features and functionality:

"Because Autel does not make an OE tool, our primary customer is the independent technician and shop. We engineer and test our tools to provide functionality beyond the standard releases. This does require extra work and cost in engineering to accomplish. Since Autel only makes diagnostic equipment, our vast engineering teams are focused on developing just that."

Also consider adequate test leads, a sturdy hanger for the scan tool, and an adjustable volume level. Cord connections can be a problem, too. The weak point is often where the connection and the wire bundle meet. Although, cords are getting to be a thing of the past with the advent of the wireless dongle between the scan tool and the assembly line diagnostic link (ALDL). Now the only problem is not forgetting to remove the dongle before the car drives off.

UPDATES

Updates, updates, updates. This may be the biggest consideration of all. It's the downtime that is the real issue. The fact that some scan tools will display a message such as "Erasing old data" before they begin downloading the new data is a bit unnerving as well.

Some manufacturers, such as Ford, will provide the dates of the next projected updates for their scan tools so you have the option to schedule scan tool downtime. I don't believe there is ever a good time for downtime in a busy shop, but it's essential to update these tools on time, nonetheless.

FINAL THOUGHTS

With all this going on, there is still one aspect of the topic that needs a closer look. That is how to hook up the tool leads, the locations of the sensor, and the pin locations for the component you are trying to obtain the information about. Some manufacturers do a great job of providing drawings and directions for tool connections, but it is still one of the most frequently asked questions.

The novice or new apprentice/technician might not have paid attention to the initial process of hooking up the scope or scan tool, as they were far more interested in the results. When it's time to try it for themselves, they are left standing there holding the test leads and wondering what to do next.

The key is to keep honing your skills every day. This business of car repair is based on ever changing and advancing technologies. All this automotive intel can only increase a technician's knowledge base as well as their ability to adapt to the latest technologies coming from various manufacturers.





From the show to the shop

A toolbox fit for a master technician.

en Corda is not your typical automotive technician. As he explains it, he did things a bit "backwards." After having a career selling cars for many years, Corda decided it was time for a change.

"I think I got to a certain age where the money [wasn't] the driving factor," he says. "It [was more about] going to a place you want to go to every day."

Since he was about 15 years old, Corda has been working on cars, so he decided he wanted to make a career out of that. Now, he has been working at Tom's Auto Center for a little over a year and has already obtained his master technician ASE certification. Corda enjoys the challenges that come with working as a technician at an independent shop that services domestic, European, and Asian vehicles.

Before he could start his new career, though, he had to go back to school. While being back in the classroom was a bit strange for Corda, he utilized the benefits that came with being a student – namely the discounts.

Corda was able to purchase his first toolbox and many of the tools he has now at a significantly discounted price. With all the tools he was adding to his collection, his first toolbox quickly ran out of

space. But, while at a Matco Tools show in Las Vegas, Corda was able to find a new toolbox and got a good deal trading in his old one for the demo toolbox at the show.

Corda's new toolbox is a Matco RevelX, which consists of a hutch, a side cabinet, and the box itself. What's most special about this box, however, are the serial numbers.

"Because it was made specifically for the show, the hutch, the actual box, and the side cabinet all have [sequential] serial numbers," Corda says.

The toolbox is approximately 7' tall with the hutch on top, and around 8-9' long. It stands out nicely with its white surface, blue trim, and stainless-steel tops. Additionally, the box comes with LED lighting.

"It's got more bells and whistles than I probably need, [but with] the deal and what I was looking for, I couldn't really pass it up," he says.

Corda's favorite part of the toolbox is the side cabinet.

"[It's] because it gets all of the specialty

tools out of the other drawers and I can basically store everything in there," he says.

When it comes to organization, Corda likes things to be laid out for maximum efficiency. Each tool has a home and is grouped together with like tools.

"There [are] three big drawers on the top," he says. "It's basically sockets and rachets in one, then the next one down is pretty much all my wrenches, and then screwdrivers and everything is below that."

Corda keeps the hutch and side cabinet just as organized. In the hutch, it's set up for any of the aerosol products necessary for the job – spray lubes, greases, and cleaners. Then, he's got all of his specialty tools in the side cabinet.

For further organization, Corda uses organizer trays for almost everything.

"All the sockets are laid where if it's a 1/4" or 1/2", they're all on trays, so it's pretty easy to find," he says.

Though Corda has only owned this toolbox for six months now, he's already thinking of purchasing another. **PTEN**
